### Baseball – Softball Guidelines

The following policies and standards will be in place for baseball and softball during the 2010 season.

- Umpires are encouraged to be at the game site twenty minutes prior to the game and the jurisdiction of the officials will begin in accordance with Federation Rules. Umpires shall notify home management upon their arrival at the game site. They shall introduce themselves to the home and visiting coaches.
- Umpires, contact your partner two days before game date to discuss travel and arrival plans. If any emergency occurs and umpires are going to be late, they shall contact the home school and Bill Gubel.
- If partner is someone other than the umpire on your schedule, contact Bill Gubel with the change. Officials are encouraged to officiate only one assignment on the same day.
- Payment to the umpires will be made March 26, April 23, May 20, 2010, and end of season..
- UMPIRES shall prepare physically and mentally, dress appropriately (per Federation rules), and comport themselves in a manner consistent with the high standards of the profession. Uniforms shall be clean and in good condition; caps new or nearly new; shoes clean, shined, and in good condition. Jewelry shall not be worn except for religious or medical medals, wedding rings, and wrist watches for those officials required to perform timing duties. Dress discreetly when changing to uniform in parking lots.
- Athletic Directors and/or coaches are to contact assigned officials for all schedule changes. Bill Gubel should also be contacted.
- No changes of any assignments unless cleared by JSS personnel. If there are any concerns in scheduling contact Bill Gubel. SCHOOLS - if you have a change in assignment (date, time, place), please notify Bill Gubel by email. Check schedule and web regularly.
- In the event of illness, injury or circumstances preventing an umpire from carrying out an assignment, the umpire is responsible for immediately notifying Bill Gubel. No umpire shall assign himself to a game. Games, without pay, approved for training will be assigned by the NCOA or Bill Gubel.
- Consumption of alcoholic beverages/controlled substances on the day of a contest, prior to that contest, is absolutely forbidden. Umpires are reminded that CIF schools are tobacco free (smoking and chewing). This includes parking lots.
- Any unusual circumstances involving the conduct of coaches, players, or spectators should be reported immediately to Bill Gubel.
- Please follow CIF Federation procedures regarding all rules. If there is a forfeit, cancellation, or change in the regular schedule, please notify Bill Gubel.
- Umpires are advised not to place their hands upon players, coaches, or spectators except as directed by the rulebook.
- Umpires are reminded that an evaluator, assessor, or commissioner may observe their work. The observers may talk with the umpires following the game.
- If you have a complaint regarding sportsmanship, conduct of coaches or players or safety issues, contact Bill Gubel/Jim Jorgensen. Addressing the media/press or school personnel shows poor judgment and sportsmanship and is against CIF policies.
