Soccer Guidelines

The following policies and standards will be in place for soccer officials during the 2010-11 season.

- Officials are encouraged to be at the game site twenty minutes prior to the game. Jurisdiction of the officials is in accordance with Federation Rules. The referee is responsible for conducting a pre-game conference. Officials shall contact each other prior to the match to discuss game time, location, and travel arrangements.
- Officials shall notify the home management upon arrival. If delayed, the official shall contact the school. Parking at the school site is the responsibility of the officials. Check with personnel upon your arrival for proper parking instructions.
- OFFICIALS shall prepare physically and mentally, dress neatly, and appropriately (per Federation rules), and comport themselves in a manner consistent with the high standards of the profession. Uniforms shall be clean and in good condition; shoes clean, shined and in good condition. Jewelry shall not be worn except for religious or medical medals, wedding rings and wrist watches for those officials required to perform timing duties.
- In the event of illness, injury or circumstances preventing an official from carrying out an assignment, the official is responsible for immediately notifying John Rafferty.
- *NO CHANGES* of any assignments unless cleared by JSS personnel. If there are any concerns in scheduling, please contact John Rafferty. SCHOOLS - All changes in assignment must be made on arbiter.
- Officials who are late to NCSOA assignments or are a no show for a contest will be referred to the NCSOA - John Rafferty. Officials contact your partner/partners regarding travel plans prior to the game.
- Authorized visitors in the dressing facility may be timers, score keepers, Athletic Directors, coaches, assigner of officials and/or observers. Coaches should not enter the dressing area following the game.
- The use of alcoholic beverages/controlled substances on the day of a contest prior to that contest is absolutely forbidden. Officials are reminded that CIF schools are tobacco free (smoking and chewing).
- Follow CIF/National Federation procedures regarding all rules. If there is a forfeit, notify John Rafferty. Any unusual circumstances involving the conduct of coaches, players, contact John Rafferty/Monty Muller immediately. If there has been a fight/ejection/red card, notify John Rafferty/Monty Muller promptly. It is the responsibility of the official who DQ/ejected (or any unusual activity/concern) a player/coach to email John Rafferty or Monty Muller and leave a voice mail message and follow it up with a written report by 10 a.m. the following morning.
- Officials are encouraged not to place their hands upon players, coaches, or spectators.
- Officials are reminded that their work may be observed by an Assigner of Officials, JSS, and NCSOA observers. The observers may wish to talk with the officials following the game.
- Game reports are to be completed on arbiter within five days (one day when within a day of the end of the payroll period) of the assignment. The game reports are your invoices to acknowledge your completion of assignments for payroll purposes. Officials are independent contractors and payment to officials will be available on RefPay on *September 29, October 27, and November 10*.
- Addressing the media/press or school personnel shows poor sportsmanship and is against NCSOA/CIF policies.
- If Athletic Directors have a complaint, please contact John Rafferty/Monty Muller. Criticizing in the media or press or berating an official shows poor sportsmanship and is against CIF policies.
